Paint	Check colour variation - overspraying/dents/ripples		
Engine appearance:	Any dirt? Or oil build-up? = poor maintenance/mechanical problems		
Engine oil:	Dirty or thick? Sludge in engine = lack of maintenance grey or milky coloured oil = presence of water serious engine problems		
Engine at idle:	Any knocking/rattling noises? Irregular running?		

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Exhaust System:		Fumes? Or excessive noise = holes or rust in pipes/mufflers	
Oil fumes:		Remove oil filler cap while engine idling. Fumes =	
		worn piston rings/cylinder	
Radiator coolant:		Should be clean & brightly coloured. Oil in coolant	
		cracked cylinder head or a leaking gasket.
