Bath Salts

Shortbread

250g butter 1 cup icing sugar 1 cup corn flour 1 1/2 cup plain flour

Cream butter and sugar; add corn flour and plain flour. Often in summer this dough needs refrigerating till firm enough to cut/shape. You can use a shortbread mould or roll it into small rolls and cut it about 1cm thick and bake like that. Bake in a moderate oven for 10-12 minutes until golden.

Rocky Road

large block chocolate (375g)
g copha
pkt marshmallows
pkt glace cherries
pkt soft jubes
1/2 cup shredded coconut (optional)

Melt the chocolate and copha and mix well. Quickly add the other ingredients, mixing to coat with the chocolate. Pour into a foil lined lamington tin. Refrigerate until set. Break into rough chunks. Place some on a paper plate, wrap in cellophane and tie off with curling ribbon for a pretty and yummy teacher appreciate gift.
